Passports must be a Normal Passport type with validity of more than 6 months from UAE Entry date to be eligible for visa on arrival.

If you are a passport holder of the below country or territory, no advance visa arrangements are required to visit the UAE. Simply disembark your flight and proceed to immigration, where your passport will be stamped with a 30-day visit visa free of charge.

Citizens of the below European countries are also entitled to apply for a pre-arranged visit visa if their 90-day visa on arrival has been fully utilized.
